House cats and other indoor animals are prohibited by our governing documents and must be removed from the premises immediately. Owners are subject to fines and possible litigation for violations.

Please be respectful of others in the common areas, like the pools, tennis courts, parking areas, etc. These amenities are common properties.

The cameras around the complex are there for security purposes. If anyone needs to view a section of the video feed, you must make a formal written complaint to the office, such as "my bicycle was stolen on such and such date and approximate time" or other such report. Then the office will review the video to determine if it is any help in resolving the matter, such as a license plate. If it is deemed to be of help, we will let law enforcement view the video. It will not be released to any owner or resident directly.

Seasonal Rentals Reminder

If you're renting out your unit seasonally through platforms like Airbnb, VRBO, or any other rental service, please remember that all rentals must adhere to the association's guidelines. Specifically:

- Minimum rental period: 2 months
- Maximum rental period: 6 months
- All rental applications must be submitted and approved by the Condo Association prior to the start of any tenancy. Remember that this process takes up to two weeks.
