Hello everyone! As summer is winding down and hopefully there are no more bad storms on the way, we are preparing for the snowbirds to begin arriving over the next few months.

I wanted you all to know that we are working diligently to take care of some of the preventive maintenance items that demand attention. We have begun the process of systematically cleaning the plumbing drain stacks on a rotating basis to have all the buildings done over the course of the next 12 months. Once finished, the rotation will start again.

You may also be aware that the last two storms took a heavy toll on Village Brooke. We had to make extensive repairs to the rear area parking lot and had to remove another tree in front of Building 5 that fell by the last storm. This tree hit the building, doing damage to two lanais and the roof and downspout. The back pool deck is in the process of being re-sealed. By the time you read this, it may already be completed.

We have also discovered a serious termite infestation in building 7 that requires tenting and fumigating the entire building. This is a three-day process and disrupts the peaceful enjoyment of the premises by those who live in that building. This is a very expensive project; one I hope we don't have to repeat any time soon. We are still looking into an alternative treatment if possible.
